



This is so far what people in Leicestershire have told us we should ask of all candidates for the Police and Crime Commissioner;

1. What do they see is happening now with regards to disproportionality in stop and search, arrest rates and custody referral and what will they do to reduce this?
2. Will they ensure the reintroduction of recording of **all** stops.
3. Will they research and implement improving intelligence led stops and search, improving effectiveness and alternatives to stop and search?
4. Will they be addressing the issue of discrimination?
5. Will there be a reform of the complaints procedure and how will they gain the confidence of the public that it works? Within a complaints system it should allow for third party reporting, which will allow those who have little confidence to come forward.
6. What will they do to ensure better monitoring of police actions, better discipline and that any wrong doing/ discrimination by police officers result in serious consequences e.g. dismissal.
7. How will they ensure they are not making false promises and that there will be an honest, straightforward change in the way of policing.
8. How will they address the issue of better police and community relationships and confidence in policing which should take into account ensuring the police treat the public with dignity and respect?
9. How will they ensure policing panels/ boards will represent the communities they serve and how will they bring about meaningful community engagement?
10. How will the PCC make themselves and the police of Leicestershire transparent and accountable?
